



TALK 1 — Noah and the Flood - "STEP IN THE DOOR"

Theme: Salvation | Genesis 6–9

Discussion Questions

Understanding:

Why do you think God chose to save Noah and his family instead of starting completely over? What does that tell us about God's heart?

Personal Reflection:

Have you ever gone through a "storm season" in your life where things felt out of control? How did that affect your faith?

Application:

The ark was the only safe place during the flood. What does it look like today to "step into the ark" by trusting Jesus?

TALK 2 — Moses on Mount Sinai & Israel in the Desert - "SHOW ME YOUR FACE"

Theme: Purification & Preparation | Exodus 19–34, Numbers 1–14

Discussion Questions

Understanding:

Why do you think the Israelites struggled so much in the desert even after seeing God do miracles?

Personal Reflection:

What are some "idols" or distractions that make it hard for people our age to wait on God or trust Him fully?

Application:

How can God use seasons of waiting or difficulty to prepare us for something better in the future?



TALK 3 — Jesus in the Wilderness - "I'VE BEEN SET FREE"

Theme: Freedom | Matthew 4

Discussion Questions

Understanding:

Why do you think Jesus faced temptation right after being baptized and affirmed by God?

Personal Reflection:

Which of the three temptations (comfort, attention, or control) do you think is hardest for YOU today—and why?

Application:

Jesus used God's Word to fight temptation. What are some practical ways students can rely on God when facing temptation this week? Have YOU hidden God's word in your heart?

TALK 4 — Jesus After the Resurrection (40 Days Before Ascension) - "CARRY THE FIRE"

Theme: Mission & Purpose | Acts 1, Luke 24

Discussion Questions

Understanding:

Why do you think Jesus stayed on earth for 40 days after the resurrection instead of immediately ascending to heaven?

Personal Reflection:

Have you had moments with Jesus that cause your heart to burn in a GOOD way like the disciples on the road to emmaus?

Application:

Jesus said His followers would be His witnesses. What does that look like practically in your school, friend group, or family? How can YOU "Carry The Fire"?
